## ENTRY LEVEL

Learning at this level involves building general knowledge and skills to give you confidence to move on to other courses or into employment.

**Qualifications include:**

Entry 1, Entry 2 and Entry 3 (in a range of subjects)

**Entry requirements:** None

## LEVEL 1

Level 1 qualifications will give you basic knowledge and skills and the ability to work with guidance or supervision. Learning at this level can start you on your career path.

**Qualifications include:**

NVQ1; GCSEs Grades 3-1 (Grades D-G); Level 1 Diploma

**Entry requirements:**

Entry Level Certificate or 2 GCSEs Grades 2-1 (Grades E-G)

## LEVEL 2

Learning at this level involves building knowledge and/or skills in relation to an area of work or a subject area and can be applied to many job roles as Level 2 qualifications show employers that you've reached a nationally recognised standard.

**Qualifications include:** NVQ2; GCSEs Grades 9-4 (Grades A\*-C); Level 2 Diploma; Apprenticeships

**Entry requirements:** 4 GCSEs Grade 3 or above (A\*-D); Equivalent qualification eg: Introductory Certificate, NVQ Level 1

## LEVEL 3

Learning at this level involves obtaining detailed knowledge and skills. Level 3 qualifications are appropriate for people wishing to progress to university or, in some areas, supervising and training others in their field of work as you will have reached a nationally recognised standard.

**Qualifications include:** NVQ3; A Levels; Level 3 Extended Diploma; Advanced Apprenticeships

**Entry requirements:** Level 2 Diploma – Merit or above, 5 GCSEs Grade 4 or above (A\*-C). You may also need Grade 4 or above (A\*-C) in Maths and English.

## LEVEL 4/5/6

These are degree level courses and learning at this level involves a high amount of in-depth study.

**Qualifications include:** NVQ4; Foundation Degree; HNC/HND; BA (Hons); Teaching Qualifications; Higher Level Apprenticeships

**Entry requirements:** A Levels, Level 3 Diploma, NVQ Level 3 (in a related subject)



### **Certificate for Dog Grooming Assistants** (City & Guilds)

There are no formal entry requirements. You will be expected to buy the correct PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) and scissor sets from the college. A placement within a grooming salon would be an advantage but is not a course requirement.

## LEVEL 3

### **Extended Diploma in Animal Management** (City & Guilds)

You will need GCSE Grade 4/C in Maths and English and Science.

You will be expected to buy your own overalls and steel toe-capped boots for practical work. Finding a suitable placement in an animal care establishment would be an advantage but is not a course requirement.

### **Diploma for Professional Dog Grooming Stylists** (City & Guilds)

You must hold the City & Guilds Level 2 Certificate for Dog Grooming Assistants prior to enrolment. You will be expected to buy the correct PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) and scissor sets from the college. A placement within a grooming salon would be an advantage but is not a course requirement.

You will need to have either:

- Five GCSEs at Grade 4/C or above, including Grade 4/C or above in both English and Maths
- Or
- A related BTEC Level 2 Extended Certificate or Diploma at Merit or above, plus Grade 4/C or above in GCSE English and Maths.






