You will study two units:-

Whilst on the course, you will be given **FREE professional membership of the CMI**, which includes access to a range of CMI products and services to support you throughout the qualification and later as you progress in their career.

# How is the Course Assessed?

Each unit is assessed by one written assignment of approximately 2,000-2,500 words.

# How is the Course Delivered?

The course is delivered fully online with **'real-time' interactive classes** taking place on Mondays 6 – 9 pm, using the Zoom video conferencing platform. Online, **on-demand learning materials are available 24/7** and are accessible by both PCs and mobile devices.

# What are the Entry Requirements?

You must have gained a minimum of five GCSEs at grade C or above including English or equivalent qualifications.

However, if you are a mature applicant (over 21 years) your work experience (paid and/or unpaid) may be taken into account in lieu of formal qualifications.

### What Progression Opportunities are there?

On successful completion of this course, you can progress to the CMI Level 3 Diploma in Management Coaching and Mentoring.
