

Chartered Management Institute (CMI) Level 5 Certificate in Project Management (Online Evening Course)

Why do this Course?

If you already manage projects within your job role <u>or</u> are likely to manage projects in the future <u>or</u> aspire to have a career in project management, then a CMI Level 5 Certificate in Project Management course may be ideal for you. The course will equip you with the **knowledge and skills required to manage projects successfully** and overcome problems and challenges during the project management process. During the course **you will plan and manage a genuine workplace project**.

How much does the Course Cost?

The total fee for this course (including registration and certification) is £600.

HOWEVER, if you live within 'West Midlands Combined Authority' region, you may be eligible to a **FREE** place on this course *subject to certain terms and conditions*.

What does the Course Involve?

You will study two units:-

- Managing Projects to Achieve Results
- Conducting a Management Project

Whilst on the course, you will be given **FREE professional membership of the CMI**, which includes access to a range of CMI products and services to support you throughout the qualification and later as you progress in their career.

How is the Course Assessed?

Each unit is assessed by one written assignment of approximately 3,500-5,000 words. The second assignment will involve proposing, conducting and reporting on a workplace management project.

How is the Course Delivered?

The course is delivered fully online with 'real-time' interactive classes taking place over eight weekly sessions held on Thursdays 6 – 9pm, using the Zoom video conferencing platform. Online, on-demand learning materials are available 24/7 and are accessible by both PCs and mobile devices.

What are the Entry Requirements?

You must have gained a minimum of five GCSEs at grade C or above including English or equivalent qualifications. Ideally, you will also have a CMI Level 3 Diploma or similar qualifications at level 3. However, if you are a mature applicant (over 21 years) your work experience (paid and/or unpaid) may be taken into account in lieu of formal qualifications.

What Progression Opportunities are there?

On successful completion of this course, you can progress to the **CMI Level 5 Diploma in Management and Leadership**. Upon achievement of the Level 5 Diploma, you may be eligible to apply for full membership (MCMI) or even **Chartered Membership of the CMI (CMgr)**.
