

Chartered Management Institute (CMI) Level 5 Certificate in Management and Leadership (Online Evening Course)

Why do this Course?

If you already have some management/leadership experience <u>or</u> if you plan to become a manager/leader in the future, then a CMI Level 5 Certificate in Management and Leadership course may be ideal for you. The course will equip you with an introduction to **the knowledge and skills required to be a successful manager/leader** within a **wide range of organisations** and across a **variety of employment sectors**.

How much does the Course Cost?

The total fee for this course (including CMI registration and certification) is £600.

HOWEVER, if you live within 'West Midlands Combined Authority' region, you may be eligible to a **FREE** place on this course *subject to certain terms and conditions*.

What does the Course Involve?

You will study two units:-

- Principles of Management and Leadership in an Organisational Context
- Principles of Developing, Managing and Leading Individuals and Teams to Achieve Success

Whilst on the course, you will be given **FREE professional membership of the CMI**, which includes access to a range of CMI products and services to support you throughout the qualification and later as you progress in your career.

How is the Course Assessed?

Each unit is assessed by one written assignment of approximately 4,000 – 4,500 words.

How is the Course Delivered?

The course is delivered fully online with 'real-time' interactive classes on Wednesdays from 6 – 9pm, using the Zoom video conferencing platform. Online, on-demand learning materials are available 24/7 and are accessible by both PCs and mobile devices.

What are the Entry Requirements?

You must have gained a minimum of five GCSEs at grade C or above including English or equivalent qualifications. Ideally, you will also have a CMI Level 3 Diploma or a similar qualification at level 3.

However, if you are a mature applicant (over 21 years) your work experience (paid and/or unpaid) may be taken into account in lieu of formal qualifications.

What Progression Opportunities are there?

On successful completion of this course, you can progress to the **CMI Level 5 Diploma in Management and Leadership**. After achievement of the Level 5 Diploma, you may be eligible to apply for full membership (MCMI) or even **Chartered Membership of the CMI (CMgr)**.
